Inspired by his aunt, Grady began oil painting at only nine years of age. He pursued his passion for painting and graduated with a B.A. in Art from the University of California at Santa Cruz in 1969. His education continued at the New York Art Students League, where he studied with such renowned artists as anatomist Robert Beverly Hale. Grady's unique artistic style continued to evolve through studies in Europe.

Grady's early influences ranged broadly from religious Pre-Renaissance European panels to Surrealist visions. He later found inspiration in the works of Italian and Spanish masters, most notable among these, the masterpieces of Botticelli, Caravaggio, Veronese, and Goya. Continuously fascinated by the beauty of the natural world, his subject matter includes fantasy, dream imagery and historical scenes. Since early 1970, Grady has taught life drawing, artistic anatomy and oil painting at art centers in California, Colorado, Pennsylvania and Hawaii.

Grady Keystone's original oils and sculpture have been featured by galleries in four states and hang in private collections around the world. His historical murals grace walls in Los Angeles, Ketchum, Boulder, Lyons, Denver, and most recently Honoka'a. Grady's prolific artistic nature extends into music as he has also written over 300 songs.
